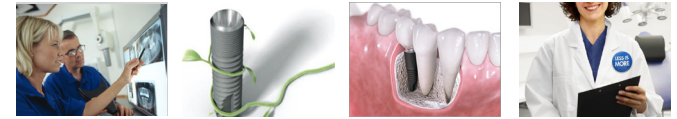

## Course Programme

### Module 1 - 27th January 2012

- Introduction to dental implants
- Patient selection
- Patient assessment
- Treatment planning
- The variety of restorative options
- Placement of implants into plastic jaw (hands-on)
- Impression taking techniques (hands-on)
- Abutment connection and fitting restoration (hands-on)
- Live patient demonstration of these techniques

Delegates will be asked to find one suitable case and will be required to bring associated radiographs and models for Module 2.

### Module 2 (pm only) - 23rd March 2012

- Overview of Module 1
- Roll of occlusion
- Aftercare and maintaining the implant patient
- Round table discussion of delegates cases

Following the course, ideally the cases can then be treated with the delegate restoring the implant in their practice with free mentoring by Dr Jacobs. Further ongoing training and free restorative mentoring will also be available.
